DID YOU KNOW?

- When new states joined the EU (early 2000s), we could have stopped people coming to work here for 7 years. Many EU countries did this. The UK chose not to.
- In many EU countries you must prove that you have a job or can support yourself after 3 months. The UK chooses not to do this.
- The UK **opted out** of joining the Schengen area (the passport-free area shared by 26 EU countries). This means WE control our own borders. That's why refugees are stuck in Calais and we have to show passports whenever we enter the UK.
